What to Bring

The following is a list of items we suggest your child brings:

- *rain jacket
- *hand sanitizer or hand soap
- *face mask

All campers items are the sole responsibility of the camper and the farm is not liable for any lost/misplaced or stolen items, though we will do the best we can to assist in their location. Campers should arrive prepared to ride.

Appropriate riding gear is mandatory. Any camper arriving without appropriate gear will forfeit their ride time for the day.

Appropriate riding gear includes; boots, pants for riding (jeans or leggings are acceptable), & shirt (sunshirts are great for hot days on a horse). The barn has helmets for riders and ALL riders will be REQUIRED to ride wearing a helmet. If you do not want your child sharing a helmet you MUST provide your own.

If your child has any medical requirements please ensure you provide those items in addition to the medical authorization form.
